The Stakes will be run in the following order:

FIRST DAY – WEDNESDAY 17th July 2019

Stake 1 NOVICE STAKE - A Stake which is confined to Pointers and Setters which have not gained a First, Second or Third in Open Stakes or First or two Seconds in All Aged, Novice or Puppy Stakes prior to the close of entries.

Stake 2 OPEN ENGLISH SETTER STAKE - A Stake in which English Setters have the opportunity of gaining a qualification towards the title of Field Trial Champion (K Regulations refer) and towards entry in the Champion Stake. It may be limited to a prescribed number of runners (J4 refers), in which case these shall be decided by a draw conducted in accordance with Regulation J7.i. so that preference is given to previous performance

Show Gundog Working Certificate – the Club may accept two entries for a Show Gundog Working Certificate which will be run before or after Stake 1 at the Judges' discretion

SECOND DAY – THURSDAY 18th July 2019

Stake 3 OPEN STAKE – A Stake in which Pointers and Setters have the opportunity of gaining a qualification towards the title of Field Trial Champion (K Regulations refer) and towards entry in the Champion Stake. It may be limited to a prescribed number of runners (J4 refers), in which case these shall be decided by a draw conducted in accordance with Regulation J7.i. so that preference is given to previous performance.

Qualifications for Open Stakes (as per Kennel Club Ltd J Regulations) to be entered on Entry Form

ENTRY FEES:

Entry Fees must accompany all entries and be the correct Sterling equivalent.

(Cheques should be made payable to the English Setter Club.)

Non-Members £20.00 Sterling

(Please send a separate cheque for each entry)

Members are reminded that the subscription is £10.00 Sterling and was DUE on 1st January. Preference will be given to fully paid up Members of the Club.

The number of entries will be limited to 45 dogs on the first day and 40 on the second day therefore; competitors are requested to specify the order of preference by writing A, B, C against the Stake number in which the dog is entered, e.g. 1A, 1B etc.

Preference on the first day will be given to Stake 2, which may result in Stake 1 becoming non-qualifying

Cheques for reserve dogs that do not get a run will be destroyed.

In the event of a Stake being abandoned due to adverse weather conditions, any refunds will be given after allowance has been made for expenses.

Everyone is reminded that running of dogs on the Trial Ground will NOT be permitted under any circumstances, except under the Judges. Competitors must make their own training arrangements. Competitors must make their own arrangements for luncheon.

Spectators and competitors must NOT follow in their own vehicles without permission, except where instructed.

The promoting club accepts no responsibility for the loss or damage to person or property however occasioned.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
- 2 The English Setter Club reserves the right to refuse entries
- 3 After entries have closed no substitute will be allowed except for bitches in season
- 4 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 5 If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot.
- 6 Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.
- 7 No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
- 8 Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
- 9 Videography and photography will only be permitted with the express permission of the Chief Steward and the host.
- 10 Welfare of Dogs
An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
11. DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS
Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
